The United States is the **#1** producing country in the world of ethanol.

Today ethanol makes up **10%** of the U.S. gasoline supply, up from **1%** 20 years ago

Today's ethanol is nearly **50% LOWER** in carbon intensity compared to gasoline.

Today's corn ethanol reduces greenhouse gas emissions, on average by **42-52%**

Illinois is ranked **third** in Ethanol production in the U.S.

Almost all gasoline sold in the United States contains at least **10%** ethanol.

Illinois has **13** ethanol plants that produce **42%** of the gasoline produced in the state.
